



Coin Set 2010 from the Royal Danish Mint

The annual Coin Set, which is issued 8 November 2010, has a maritime theme. Besides the six coins in circulation, the set includes a medal.

The coins are minted with several strokes and are thus more clearly embossed than the ordinary coins in circulation. The Coin Set is minted in a limited edition.

The obverse of the medal shows the Royal Danish Mint's mark, a heart, under a crown, while the reverse shows a copy of a medal issued on 26 May 1739 in connection with the ceremonious opening of the Danish Navy's first dry dock.

Proof version

The proof version also includes the six coins in circulation struck in the year 2010, as well as the above medal minted in fine silver.

The coins in the proof set are minted using at least three strokes with extremely well-polished dies on specially treated coin blanks in order to ensure their very fine quality. The proof set is minted in a limited edition.

Buy the new Coin Set from 8 November 2010

The new Coin Set is on sale from 8 November 2010. The recommended retail price is DKK 200 for the ordinary version and DKK 875 for the proof version. Some banks and coin dealers also accept orders.

In 2010 - coins for circulation are not produced.

The next Ship Coin

The 8th ship coin will be put into circulation by the banks on Monday, 29 November 2010. The 20-krone coin and the proof version will be on sale at the website from this date.
